

MHA[™] Multi-Heat Adhesive is a 1 mil (25µ) self-wound, heat-activated solvent acrylic adhesive with a moisture stable release liner that can be used on heated roller laminators or vacuum presses.

Unlike most pressure sensitive mounting adhesives, MHA[™] is carrier-free and has an initial low tack that allows it to be re-positioned before heat is applied to bond it to a substrate - including MDF, Masonite, GatorFoam, PVC, Sintra, and canvas - or to the back of an image such as a poster, drawing or newspaper. Once the image has been aligned on a substrate, MHA[™] then passes through a heated laminator or is put in a vacuum press to activate the adhesive and instantly create a strong, permanent bond.

The properties of MHA[™] allow it to self-trim, making it perfect for die cut shapes or similar applications. It is also ideal for mounting canvas, manufacturing plaques, and creating a strong bond between substrates. Available in widths up to 51" (1295mm).

To create flawless, perfectly aligned images, MHA[™] is recommended for use with Drytac's MediaShield[™] or MHL[™] laminating films.
